Pancake Breakfast: Erik Finstad/Darrel Kyle(Mason's Contact): Darrel said they would love to come back and run the breakfast again this year. Michelle Hintz said her family will donate the syrup and would also like to see their syrup at the breakfast as well.

Vendors/Crafts: Paula Davey has resigned. She has done a wonderful job and will help with the transition. Brian said Julie Roberts is considering it and will let us know within the week.

Band & Stage: *Erik Finstad/Craig Golembiewski (Cody Eagle-Stage):* The committee voted to have Last Call back again this year. Cody has spoken with Randy Moey and he will provide the stage.
